# Transferring between Clubs and Regions

## What you need to know

- This fact sheet outlines Baseball Queensland's transfer rules for junior players, from Little League to Senior League (U16) age groups, and how this might affect your ability to represent your region in Div 1 State titles.

### Transferring to another club

- A player can transfer between clubs anywhere in Queensland.
- A clearance from the secretary of the player's previous club will be needed, to ensure financial and other obligations have been met.
- For these transfers, the clearance process happens through Sports LOMO when the player registers for the new club. The player must request a transfer in the Sports LOMO system.

### Transferring from 1 region to another region and being eligible to play for the region in Division 1 teams

- A player transferring from one club to another club where the new club is outside their previous region (eg. from Surfers Paradise (Gold Coast region) to All Stars Baseball Club (Brisbane Metro region)) must first obtain a clearance from their club they have come from (see Transferring to another club).
- At the same time, fill out transferring documents which go to the previous region for sign off and to Baseball Queensland.
- The new region will advise the player once the clearance is given, which should be within 14 days but this can be longer depending on the clearances from club to region and then to Baseball Queensland.

- If the player has appeared on a Team Roster the previous year from the region they have come from, they may not be eligible to play for the region they are going to for 1 year. This is relevant to players wanting to be considered for Division 1 teams.
- However, the player may be exempt from this restriction if:
  - The player has moved to a residential address in the new region's area
  - There are other extenuating circumstances. Please talk to the region if you believe there are other circumstances, and we will discuss with Baseball Queensland. Please put this in writing to the secretary at [brisbanetrobaseball@gmail.com](mailto:brisbanetrobaseball@gmail.com).
- An exemption is granted by Baseball Queensland.
- There is an appeal process in relation to decisions about exemptions.
